Wixson Scholarship History

The Wixson's were a family of 5 children, 3 daughters and 2 sons, none of whom ever married. They moved to Myrtle Creek, Oregon from New York State around 1906. The Wixson daughters all became school teachers and it was through their dedication to education that they decided to leave their estate, in trust, to be used to support learning opportunities for generations to come.

To qualify, the applicant must have been enrolled at a high school at Days Creek, Glendale, Riddle, South Umpqua, or Canyonville Christian Academy at the beginning of their senior year. Scholarship recipients must attend a College, University or Trade School located in Oregon.

The Umpqua Youth Trust Foundation also asks that you return one-half of this scholarship grant after you have completed your education and are gainfully employed. This should be done in a way that is convenient for you at that time. This is considered a donation and is tax deductible.
